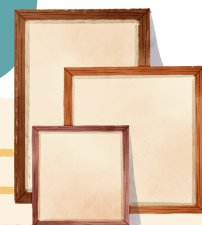


## Categories

### Youth Art Contest

The National Park Service (NPS) is celebrating National Park Week April 20 – 28, 2024. To celebrate this exciting week Theodore Roosevelt Nature & History Association will be hosting a youth art contest.

The theme for this art contest is *Spring into Theodore Roosevelt National Park*, where children can draw their favorite things to do or see in Theodore Roosevelt National Park

Entries to the contest will be displayed in the South Unit Visitor Center of Theodore Roosevelt National Park between April 20 -April 28, 2024. April 20, 2024 is a NPS fee free day (no entry fees apply to enter Theodore Roosevelt National Park). All applicable entry fees apply for the remainder of the week April 21-28, 2024.

Submissions will be accepted in three grade-level categories:

K-2 grade, 3-5 grade, and 6-8 grade

### What to do:

#### 1) Create your artwork

Hand draw, color, or paint your favorite thing to do or see in Theodore Roosevelt National Park

Entry must be no larger than 8.5" x 11"

All paper types will be accepted (digital images and photography will not be accepted)

Back of the entry must include artist's name, age, and parent/guardian email and phone number

Only one entry per person

All entries must be original work

#### 2) Complete forms

When the artwork is complete, fill out the entry form and participant waiver

### 3) Submit

Submissions can be dropped off at the South Unit Visitor Center of Theodore Roosevelt National Park or mailed to:

Submissions (original artwork, entry form, and participant waiver) must be received by 4:30 pm MT, April 17, 2024. Artists will be able to pick up their submissions beginning April 28, 2024. **No submissions will be mailed back to the artist.**

All timely submissions will be judged by TRNHA staff. Winning submissions will be announced April 20, prizes will be awarded to winners within each grade category. Grand prize winner will receive a 2024 America the Beautiful National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass.
